Incident Summary:
On Monday, January 20, 2025, at 12:10AM, Columbus Police Officers were called to the 1400 block of Slade Ave. on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found Tremain Russell, 33, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Medic 11 transported Russell to Riverside Hospital in critical condition, where he was pronounced deceased at 12:41AM.

Cierra Locke-Shelby, 30, is the mother of Russell's children. Locke-Shelby stated she and Russell were arguing and she was holding a handgun during the argument. According to Locke-Shelby, the argument got heated and she was waiving the handgun about when it discharged and the projectile struck Russell. Locke-Shelby claimed the handgun was faulty and that its discharge was unintentional. Locke-Shelby remained at scene and summoned medical assistance for Russell. The weapon in question was also recovered at scene.

Detectives have charged Locke-Shelby with Reckless Homicide. Locke-Shelby is currently incarcerated in the Franklin County Jail.
