Incident Summary:

On July 9, 2025, at 6:10 p.m. Columbus Police officers responded to the 1400 block of Polaris Pkwy. on a reported shooting. Upon arrival, officers located the victim, identified as JOSEPH SUITER, age 26, who was unresponsive and had suffered a gunshot wound. Columbus Fire medics responded to the scene and the victim was pronounced deceased at 6:19 p.m. Next of kin notification has been made.

The preliminary investigation revealed a drug transaction as a possible motive. Witnesses at the scene identified the suspect, ELIJAH ROBERTS, age 19, as the person who shot the victim. After detectives obtained an arrest warrant, Roberts was arrested by Columbus SWAT officers at a nearby residence. Because the homicide occurred in Delaware County, Roberts was slated into the Delaware County Jail.
