Incident Summary: Update #1-On July 6, 2025, the Franklin County Coroner's office identified the deceased as Cameron Moore, M/B 17. NOK has been notified. Homicide detectives are asking for the public's help. It's estimated that more than 100 people (mostly teenagers) were at this "Pop up" party. If you have any video or see any video from this incident, please submit it to detectives using the attached QR code or contact Columbus Police Homicide. The public's help is essential in identifying the perpetrator(s) of this tragedy.

On July 4, 2025, CPD Patrol personnel were dispatched on the report of a shooting in the 800 block of Wilson Ave.. Upon arrival, officers located 3 victims suffering from gunshot wounds. One juvenile victim was transported to Grant Hospital and pronounced deceased at 3:09pm. Three (3) additional victims, suffering gunshot wounds were transported to OSU hospital for treatment and are expected to survive. In total this incident had six (6) shooting victims. At this time, no positive identification of the victim has been confirmed. Homicide detectives are investigating and are requesting the public's help with any information of what occurred during this shooting incident.
