Incident Summary: On 6/26/2025 at 1:49 am, an adult was standing behind a 2003 Hyundai Sonata. It was stopped on eastbound I-70 in the number 1 lane. At the same time, an adult was operating a 2006				

Incident Summary: On 6/26/2025 at 1:49 am, an adult was standing behind a 2003 Hyundai Sonata. It was stopped on eastbound I-70 in the number 1 lane. At the same time, an adult was operating a 2006 Saturn S2 on I-70 in the number 2 lane. The Saturn attempted to pass the vehicle in front of it and changed from the number 2 lane into the number 1 lane. The front of the Saturn struck the adult pedestrian, then the rear of the Hyundai. The impact pushed the Hyundai into the cable median guardrail. The Saturn rotated counterclockwise into the number 2 lane, where it came to rest. The adult pedestrian was thrown over the Hyundai and came to rest in the number 1 lane. Columbus Fire Medic #32 transported the adult to Mt. Carmel East Hospital in critical condition. The adult pedestrian was pronounced dead at 3:02 am. A witness stated that the Hyundai did not have any lights on at the time of the crash.

The Columbus Police Accident Investigation Unit responded to the crash scene and initiated an investigation, which is still ongoing.
