Incident Summary: On June 28 at approximately 1:10am, Columbus Police Patrol Officers were dispatched to the 6200 block of Thornton Rd. on the report of a stabbing. Upon arrival, Patrol officers located two adult victims suffering from apparent cutting/stabbing wounds. Initial information at scene indicated the incident resulted out of a domestic dispute. It was also learned a small child had been taken from the scene. Both adult victims were taken to a local area hospital and are expected to recover from their injuries. As a result of the child being taken, an AMBER Alert was issued.				
Within several hours of the initial incident, the suspect was apprehended and the child was safely recovered.				
A joint investigation was initiated with the Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Units of the Columbus Division of Police. The suspect was processed, charged with two counts of Felonious Assault and one count of kidnapping. The investigation continues.
