Incident Summary: ***UPDATE June 16, 2025*** On June 15, 2025, at 12:36 PM, despite all efforts by medical personnel, Mr. Jusiah Mason was pronounced deceased as a result of the injury he sustained. Next of kin have been notified.				
On June 14, 2025, at approximately 3:15 AM, Columbus Police Patrol officers were dispatched to the area of S. Ludlow Street and W. Town Street on report of a shooting. Officers arrived at scene and located five adult and one juvenile shooting victims. A juvenile was also located suffering non gunshot related injuries. Various CFD Medic Units transported the victims to several local hospitals. All but one of the victims are in stable condition. One of the adult victims is in critical condition. Due to the severity of that victim's injuries, the Homicide Unit is conducting the investigation.				
An additional adult victim later self-transported themselves to a local hospital with a gunshot wound. That victim is also in stable condition.				
Detectives believe there was a large gathering of individuals present at the time of the incident. it is asked that anyone who may have video, photographs, or other digital evidence use the attached QR code to upload that evidence to assist with the investigation. The submission may remain anonymous, and no account is required.
