Police-Involved Shooting

On June 11, 2025, at 3:12 p.m., Columbus Division of Police officers working special duty at the Lincoln Park Pool, located in the 500 block of East Woodrow Avenue, aired they heard gunshots being fired from the Barack Recreation Center parking lot.

A short time later, officers on bicycles located three possible male suspects in the rec center parking lot. One of the three males immediately ran on foot and was taken into custody a short distance away. While that male was running, he threw a firearm over the fence to the pool, which was recovered by officers.

One of the two males who stayed in the parking lot ignored commands being given by officers and began crouching down by a parked vehicle. That male produced a firearm, at which time one officer discharged their firearm, striking the male. That male was transported to a local hospital in stable condition.

The third male was taken into custody in the parking lot. A BB gun was recovered from his person.

All three males are juveniles. One is 16-years-old and the other two are 15-years-old.

The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation is investigating the police-involved shooting by CPD.
