Incident Summary:
On March 4, 2026, at approximately 6:28 p.m., Columbus Fire Department medics responded to a residence in the 1700 block of Holburn Ave. on a report of an ill adult female. CFD Medic 15 transported Thomasena Crowder, 63, from her residence to Grant Medical Center for medical treatment.

During the course of medical treatment, it was determined that Crowder had sustained injuries consistent with an assault. Over the following days, Crowder's condition declined.

On March 6, 2026, at 3:04 p.m., Crowder was pronounced deceased. The Franklin County Coroner's Office subsequently ruled Crowder's death a homicide.

Crowder's death is currently under investigation by the Columbus Division of Police Homicide Unit. No additional information is being released at this time.
