Incident Summary: On 7/5/2026 at approximately 5:00 PM, an elderly Victim was sitting outside a church in the 500 block of North High Street. The Suspect approached the Victim and asked to be let into the closed building. When the Victim refused to allow the Suspect entry into the closed church, the Suspect assaulted the Victim and stole a set of keys off the Victim's person. Once in possession of the building keys, the Suspect entered the building, further assaulted the Victim and drug the Victim around the building by his ankles. The Suspect forced the Victim to unlock his apartment at which time the Suspect stole an undetermined amount of cash out of the Victim's residence.

The Suspect was described as a black male approximately fifty years of age. He is estimated to stand five feet ten inches tall while having a thinner build. The Suspect was said to have a "full" gray and black mustache at the time of the incident.
