Police-Involved Shooting **Reference MA# 12-2026**

The investigation into the police-involved shooting that occurred on Saturday, July 4, 2026, in the 3000 block of Cotton Mill, continues.

On Sunday, July 5, 2026, at 3:56 pm, Columbus Division of Police officers working the Summer Safety Initiative located and took 41-year-old Michael Magyar into custody in the wooded area near the 3200 block of S. High St. Mr. Magyar was transported to an area hospital in stable condition for injuries he had at the time of his arrest. The cause and extent of his injuries remain under investigation.

Due to Marsy's Law, the Columbus Division of Police is unable to release the identity of the officers involved. However, their years of service are as follows:

Officer #1 is a 9-year veteran of the Columbus Division of Police.

Officer #2 is a 9-year veteran of the Columbus Division of Police.

The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation is investigating the police-involved shooting by CPD.

Body-camera video will be released once it is properly redacted in accordance with Ohio Public Records laws.

The Columbus Division of Police would like to thank our community partners for the numerous calls and tips that were submitted in the past 24 hours.

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
