Incident Summary: On 07/25/2026 at approximately 2:30 pm, an adult was operating a 2020 Toyota Sienna westbound on Oakland Park Ave. making a right turn onto Cleveland Ave. For reasons unknown the Toyota left the right side of the roadway striking a light pole and entering the KFC parking lot. The Toyota traveled through the parking lot and struck a 2014 Hyundai Tucson head on while it was parked. The collision forced the Hyundai backwards through a privacy fence and into the parking lot of an apartment complex. The driver of the Hyundai was transported to Riverside Hospital in critical condition. The juvenile passenger in the Hyundai was transported to Childrens Hospital in stable condition. The driver of the Toyota was transported to Riverside Hospital in stable condition.

The Accident Investigation Unit responded to the crash scene and initiated an investigation, which is ongoing.
