Police-Involved Shooting

On Tuesday, June 2, 2026, at 11:54 p.m., Columbus Division of Police officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Wilson Avenue on a domestic violence call. The caller stated a male assaulted a female and said he was going to get a firearm.

As the officers arrived on scene and were approaching the residence on foot, they heard multiple gunshots and witnessed a male discharging a firearm. Two officers discharged their firearms, striking the male.

Officers rendered aid to the male until medics arrived. The male was transported by medics to Grant Medical Center in critical condition and was pronounced deceased at 2:01 a.m. The identity of the male, who is an adult, is being withheld pending next of kin notification.

A firearm was recovered at the scene. It is unclear at this time who or what the male was shooting at as the officers were approaching.

The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation is investigating the police-involved shooting by CPD.

Body-camera video will be released once it is properly redacted in accordance with Ohio Public Records laws.
