**Incident Summary:** On 3/15/2026 at 10:17 pm, an adult was pushing a shopping cart northbound in the #2 lane of northbound Georgesville Rd. south of Hall Rd. At the same time an adult was operating a 2014 Ford Fusion northbound in the #2 lane of northbound Georgesville Rd. between Parkwick Dr. and Hall Rd. The front of the Fusion struck the back of the adult pedestrian. The impact knocked the adult pedestrian and the shopping cart off the right side of the roadway, where they struck a utility pole. The adult driver stopped and remained at the crash scene. Columbus Fire Medic #31 transported the adult pedestrian to Dr.'s West Hospital in life threatening condition. The adult pedestrian succumb to their injuries and was pronounced dead at 11:29 pm.

The Columbus Police Accident Investigation Unit responded to the crash scene and initiated an investigation, which is ongoing.
