**Incident Summary:**  
 \*\*\* UPDATE: Adult Victim #1 has been identified as HAIRACEMA SANCHEZ-SANCHEZ, age 35, and next of kin notification has been made. The investigation determined the victim was fatally attacked by her husband, identified as PORFIRIO SANCHEZ-EUFRACIO, age 38. Also, the person previously listed as Adult Victim #2 is, in fact, Mr. Sanchez-Eufracio, who was injured during the attack. The motive is confirmed as domestic violence. Detectives filed an arrest warrant for Mr. Sanchez-Eufracio charging him with Murder. On March 4, 2026, Mr. Sanchez-Eufracio was arrested and slated into the Franklin County Jail. \*\*\*

On February 23, 2026, at 8:51 AM, Columbus Police officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of Dyer Rd. on an unknown complaint. Upon arrival, the officers entered the residence and discovered ADULT VICTIM #1, who was unresponsive and injured. ADULT VICTIM #2 was also injured. Jackson Twp. Fire Medics arrived and pronounced victim #1 deceased at 9:44 AM. Victim #2 was transported to a local hospital in critical condition.
