**Incident Summary: \*\*\*Update: May 25, 2026, the deceased victim from this incident is Mark A. Rayburn-Velco, the next of kin notification has been made.\*\*\***

On May 24, 2026, patrol officers were dispatched to the 2600 Block of Glen Echo Dr. on the report of a stabbing. Officers arrived at the scene and found two victims suffering from multiple stab wounds. Officers summoned Columbus Fire medics, and both victims were transported to a local hospital in critical condition. Despite receiving life-saving medical treatment, one of the victims was pronounced deceased at 7:58 am, the other victim is likely to survive their injuries. The names of the victims are being withheld pending next of kin notification.
