Incident Summary: *** UPDATE: On December 15, 2023, an arrest warrant was filed for GABRIEL HOSINGS in this investigation charging him with Murder. On December 27, 2023, HOSINGS was arrested in Ghent, WV. ***				
On December 10, 2023, at 5:07PM, Columbus Police Officers responded to a shooting in the 3700 Block of Briggs Rd. Upon arrival, they located the victim, Shawn Overly M/W/34, in a doorway suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim was transported to a local area hospital in critical condition. Despite receiving life saving medical care, the victim succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 7:56pm.				
Investigators are still attempting to determine the circumstance surrounding this incident.
