Incident Summary: On January 11, 2024, at approximately 5:05 AM, Columbus Police patrol officers responded to the 900 Block of East 21st. Avenue on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located two males in a white Chevrolet Malibu suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The Malibu had also struck several parked cars before coming to rest. Both males were transported to a local hospital. One of the males was pronounced deceased at 5:38AM, the other male is expected to survive his injuries.

The actual scene of the shooting was determined to be in the 900 Block of East 19th Avenue. Homicide detectives are asking anyone in the area with exterior cameras to review their video and contact Detective Titus at the above number if they believe they have footage related to the incident.
