Incident Summary: UPDATE #1-The victim in this case has been identified and next of kin has been notified. Thanks to community members, the suspect vehicle HAS been located. Suspect(s) unknown still have not been located or identified.

On July 25, 2024 at approximately 2:14pm, CPD Patrol Officers were dispatched to a location in the 1600 block of South High Street on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male suffering from a gunshot wound. The male was taken to Grant hospital where he was pronounced deceased at 3:06pm. Suspect(s) in this case fled the scene. At this time, Homicide investigators are looking for the attached vehicle used by the perpetrators in this murder (Pictures attached). The victim's name is being withheld pending confirmation by the Franklin County Coroner's office and notification of next of kin.

We are asking for the public's help in identifying this vehicle.
