Incident Summary: *Update: July 29, 2024, detectives have identified Duron A. Thomas Sr. as the individual who shot Jacob Coons and Victim #2. A warrant has been issued for Mr. Thomas' arrest. If you know his whereabouts, you are asked to call the Columbus Police Department or 614-461-TIPS (8477).*****

On July 28, 2024, patrol officers were dispatched to the 300 block of S Glenwood Ave on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers found two individuals suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Officers provided aid to the victims until Columbus Fire personnel arrived and took over care. Victim #1 was pronounced deceased at 1:50am by CFD Medic 890 personnel, they then transported victim #2 to a local hospital for a gunshot wound, that individual is expected to survive.
