Incident Summary:
On Tuesday, November 28, 2023, at 9:43PM, Columbus Police Officers were called to the 900 block of Dressage Trce on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found an adult victim suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Medic 35 transported the victim to Mount Carmel East Hospital in critical condition where they were pronounced deceased at 10:13PM.

The victim had met with two males in the parking lot of Dressage Trce for undetermined reasons. During the interaction one of the males the victim was meeting shot the victim. What prompted the shooting remains under investigation. The decedent's name is being withheld pending notification of next of kin.
