Incident Summary:

UPDATE: The Franklin County Grand Jury has indicted Brody Sieber, 39, for two counts of Murder, two counts of Felonious Assault and one count of Having Weapons while Under Disability for causing Clark and Dowler's deaths and shooting two other adult victims. Sieber was wounded during the incident and was one of the three unnamed adult victims listed in the initial media release (see below).

The three surviving victims are all adults.

On Monday, August 1, 2022, at 9:41PM, Columbus Police Officers were called to a bar in the 100 block of Rumsey Rd. on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found Glen Clark, 50, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Hamilton Township Medic 171 pronounced Clark deceased at the scene at 9:45PM. Four other adult victims also suffered gunshot wounds during this incident and were taken to Grant Medical Center. One of those adult victims, Nicholas Dowler, 34, did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 10:32PM.

All adult victims were patronizing a bar when an altercation began. This disturbance then escalated into an exchange of gun fire during which the five adult victims were wounded, two of them fatally.
