Incident Summary: On 10/06/23 at 10:54pm a maroon 2017 Hyundai Tucson was traveling eastbound on E. Woodrow Ave. approaching S. Champion Ave. at a high rate of speed. For reasons still under investigation, as the Hyundai Tucson was eastbound, it ran the stop sign at E. Woodrow Ave. and S. Champion Ave. continuing eastbound through the driveway and then into the back yard of 1848 S. Champion Ave. As the Hyundai Tucson entered the back yard of 1848 S. Champion Ave. it struck a wood pile, causing the Hyundai Tucson to roll over several times and then come to rest up right. The driver of the Hyundai Tucson was able to crawl out of the vehicle after the collision. After the collision, Columbus Police officers and CFD Medic 14 arrived on scene. CFD Medic 14 transported the driver of the Hyundai Tucson to Grant Medical Center in serious condition.

The Columbus Police Accident Investigation Unit responded to the crash scene and initiated an investigation. The crash remains under investigation.
