

Quick Reference Scenarios

When sidewalks abut a street, the walks are considered the PAR. When a street doesn't have sidewalks, the street is considered the PAR.

4W-6_AR Unsignalized arterial (ROAD A) shall have curb ramps crossing once.	4W-8-SIG_AR At signalized arterial intersections, where sidewalks exist, both crossing are required.	3W-6 SIG At signalized arterial intersections, where sidewalks exist, both crossing are required.	3W-2 Alley When a street and alley intersect, there are no legal crosswalks because it is not an intersection. Therefore no PAR crosses street.	3W-2X Alley A PAR does cross the ally and curb ramps are required.
