

LIVINGSTON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS - 18TH STREET TO NELSON ROAD

DESCRIPTION AND BENEFITS

This project consists of designing improvements to the Livingston Avenue corridor from the 18th Street to Nelson Road. The recommendation is to perform a lane reallocation to reduce the travel lanes and provide improvements that will increase safety for all users. Grant support, scope development, detailed design, community place making, public involvement, and traffic analysis/alternatives are anticipated tasks on the contract. A safety study was initiated by the City that included public engagement with a steering committee made up of community members.
