This project consists of design for a new shared use path (SUP) along the west side of Sancus Boulevard from Lakeview Plaza Boulevard/Worthington-Galena Road to Worthington Woods Boulevard.

ESTIMATED SCHEDULE

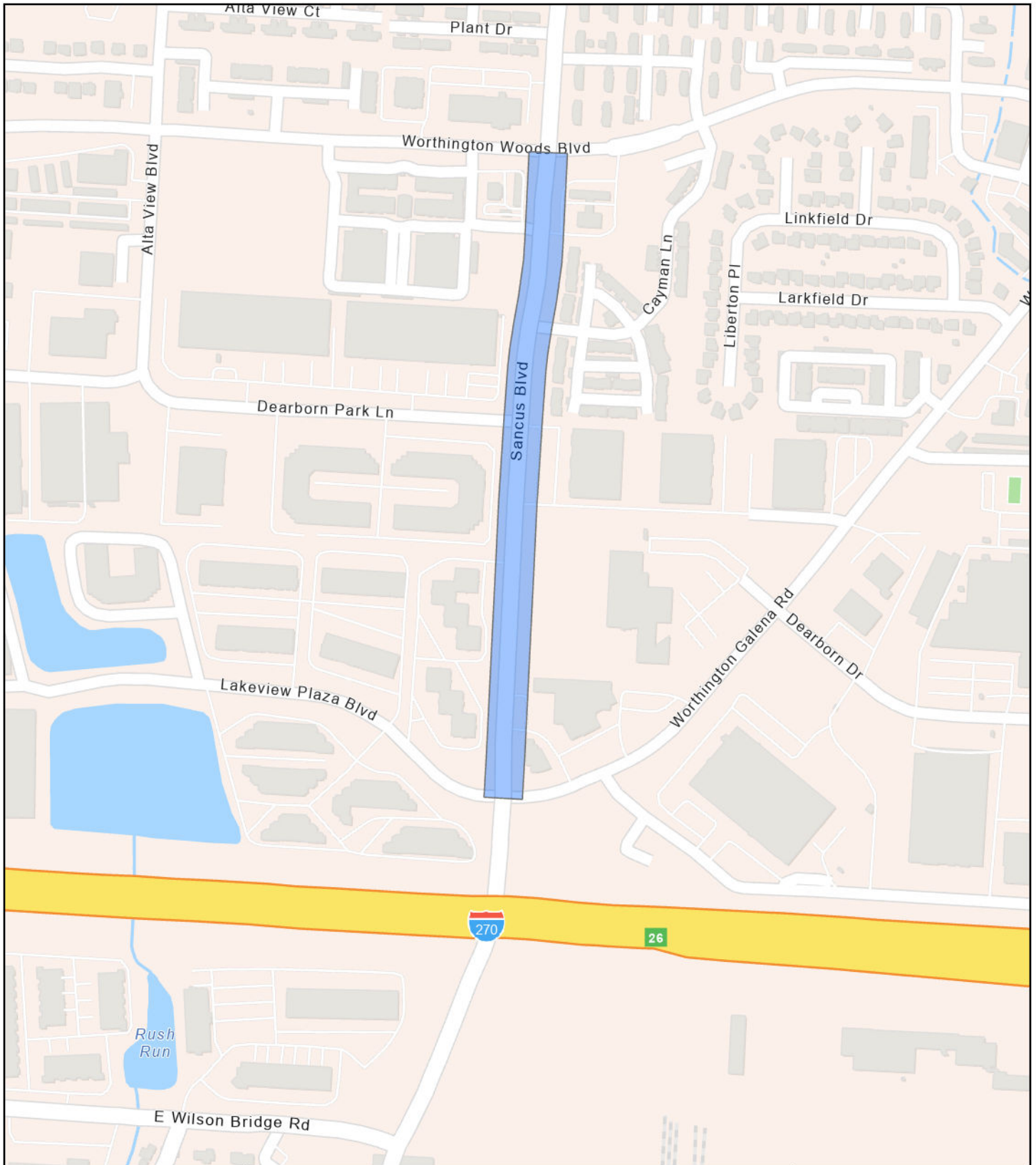

| Private Utility Relocations | Spring 2025 | Late 2025 |
| Construction | Late 2025* | Late 2027* |
