The City of Columbus also offers <u>yard waste collection</u> as part of Refuse Service. Weekly yard waste pick-up is provided to 227,000 homes.

The yard waste collection page includes information such as: acceptable materials for pick-up, how to prepare yard waste for pick-up, items that will NOT be collected with yard waste and composting information.

Privately Owned and Operated Yard Waste Collection and Composting Centers:

These locations are available throughout the year for City of Columbus and Franklin County residents free of charge. **Residents may be** asked to show driver's license or other proof of residency. Commercial landscaping companies are required to pay a fee. Acceptable materials must be in biodegradable bags and may include:

- Leaves
- Grass Clippings
- Bundled Twigs & Branches cut into lengths of 4 feet and bundled with twine or string
- Garden Waste
