

Residential On-Street ADA Parking Application

Residential On-Street ADA Parking Program Requirements

The City of Columbus Division of Parking Services will approve and install residential on-street ADA parking signage to provide additional access opportunities for residents. ADA parking signage requests are generally approved if the following criteria are met:

- Request is at a residence located on a public street within the city of Columbus
- Resident has a current ADA placard or ADA license plate from the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles
- Residence does not have access to off-street parking (i.e. driveway, garage, parking pad)

Please note: The physical condition, or use of the off-street parking at the residence (i.e. a garage used for storage, non-functioning overhead garage door, unpaved parking area that is not properly maintained) shall not constitute a basis for approving an application.

Please note: The ADA parking space is not limited to the applicant use only, but anyone with a current ADA placard or license plate may legally park in the space.
