





# **Health Savings Account - FAQ's**

#### • Can I sign up online?

 Yes, go to our website <u>www.cmefcu.org</u>. See your HR representative for step by step instructions.

#### How do I change my address?

- Log into "Online Banking" at our website <u>www.cmefcu.org</u>
- ClickContact > Send Message > fill in form & we will update that!

## • Can I make extra contributions outside of my payroll deduction?

- Yes, this will be considered a "post-tax contribution", not to exceed annual IRS guidelines.
- Stop in one of our five (5) centrally located branches. See our website for addresses.

### • What if I need an additional debit card or replacement card?

o Contact our Call Center at 888-224-3108, they will provide you an HSA Authorized user form for you to complete to order an additional card.

# • How can I reset my PIN number?

• You can call 800-290-7893 and follow the prompts – it is in 'real-time' so it will happen automatically

#### • What happens if I leave my employer? What happens to myaccount?

 That account is still yours to keep and use. Keep in mind it must be for IRS approved medical charges/services. You cannot contribute more money after you leave, unless you are covered by another High Deducible Medical Plan.

• Yes, but there is a \$2 fee – if you sign up for e-statements there is no fee!
