Crisis Intervention Services

- Walk-in crisis mental health and substance abuse services at 199 S. Central Ave. – door number 1 - for adults 18 years or older
- We often receive referrals from law enforcement, hospitals and the community
- Available 24/7/365







Assessment Services

- Mental health and substance abuse assessments and referral services
 - Provided at 199 S. Central Ave., Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
 - Services are provided on walk-in basis, no appointment necessary

- In 2017, ERS handled 84,843 calls and received an average of 147 incoming calls per day

 Launched in February 2017

- Individuals can click chat tab on any page of Netcare's website, the Franklin County ADAMH website or other ADAMH agencies and be connected to a trained crisis counselor
- Available on computers and mobile devices



Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU)

- Located at 199 S. Central Ave., door 3
- Alternative to hospitalization; up to 7 day stay
- Voluntary admission
- Individual and group therapy, psychiatric care, medication and linkage to community services is provided





Miles House

- Residential treatment for adults stabilizing from crisis
- Located at 2582 W. Broad Street
- Voluntary admission
- Stay up to 16 days







COMMUNITY SERVICES





Community Crisis Response (CCR)

- Provides on-scene response to traumatic situations in the community
- Services available 24/7/365
- In 2017, CCR responded to 196 incidents in the community, assisting 1,389 survivors







ROW ONE Program



 Mobile intervention service transporting people who are publicly inebriated to a place of safety





PROBATE AND FORENSIC SERVICES





Forensic Center

- Provides court-ordered forensic evaluations for 13 courts in 11 Central Ohio counties
- Provides evaluations for Franklin County Municipal and Juvenile Courts







Probate Pre-Screening Services

- Assessments determine if an individual meets criteria for involuntary psychiatric hospitalization, as a result of mental illness
 - Requests for services are often made by treatment providers or family members
- Staffed during Probate Court hours, Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Requests for services 24/7/365: 614-276-CARE (2273)





Family Psychological Services

- Provides assessments for youth and adults referred by FCCS and the Franklin County Juvenile Court
- Assessments seek answers to clinical rather than legal questions
- Assist with treatment planning, placement and sentencing
