SYNTERO PROGRAMS

- Collaborative Programs with Community Partners
 - Renew (COVA & Concord) provide timely, concentrated interventions in a short-term, intensive program structure to at risk young adults (18-25) following discharge from a first time inpatient mental health hospitalization.
 - Building Successful Families (PFSN) delivers in home therapy to the parents of children who have been placed in foster care or are at risk of placement.
 - Goodwill Competitive Employment Program Syntero works in tandem with Goodwill Columbus employment specialists to address the mental health needs of participants in their community-based competitive employment program.
