



Columbus Litter League 2019

League Rules

- 1. Opening Day kick off on Saturday May 18, 2019. Last day for play is Saturday August 24, 2019.
- 2. Each team must have a Captain, team name, and a roster of no more than 20 players. Any player under age 13 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other responsible adult.
- 3. Teams must select one Division in which to compete: North, South, East, or West. No team may compete in more than one Division. However, if a business or other organization sponsoring several teams, each team can select their own Division in which to play if permitted by the sponsor
- 4. Each player must complete a liability waiver.
- 5. All teams are encouraged to play on Saturday mornings if scheduling allows. Weather delays and alternative game days are allowed.
- 6. Neighborhood Liaison Officers will be notified of all regularly scheduled cleanups, however, if you feel unsafe at any time please contact 614-645-4545 or in the case of an emergency dial 911.
- 7. Keep Columbus Beautiful will provide each team with equipment that includes safety vests, gloves, litter grabbers, and trash bags.
- 8. Equipment will be available for pickup at a central location within each Division, for regularly scheduled games, on the Friday morning prior to cleanup and must be returned to the same location by 3pm on Monday following the cleanup.
- 9. When playing a rescheduled game, teams must report to 1265 Marion Rd. to pick up equipment during regular business hours.
- 10. Team Captains are responsible for submitting a Score Sheet to report stats after each cleanup via Columbus Litter League website.
- 11. Teams will score 1 run for every two full bags of litter collected.
- 12. Tires and bulk items will not be included in scoring and CANNOT be collected during Litter League.
