## SPECIAL EVENTS

### BLOCK PARTY PERMITS

Organized neighborhood block parties are another way for neighbors to connect with each other while still practicing social distancing. Beginning on July 1, Columbus Recreation and Parks Department will resume issuing block party permits for up to 50 attendees on residential streets.

We recommend that people attending these events wear face coverings, maintain social distancing by staying six feet apart and sanitize high-touch surfaces and equipment between use. The permit holder must ensure everyone attending the event has access to hand sanitizer. Additionally, no communal meals or self-serve beverage options are permitted. Individuals who are not feeling well should not attend the neighborhood block party.

Residents may apply for the block party permits during the rest of the summer. To request a block party permit, a resident must complete the special event application and obtain signatures from at least 80 percent of the affected properties.
