Ordinance Briefing and Discussion

Recreation and Parks

1. To authorize the Director of Recreation and Parks to modify and extend the contract with Kone, Inc. for required maintenance and services of nine (9) elevator units in various city facilities under the purview of the Recreation and Parks Department, and to authorize the expenditure of \$23,400.00. This modification is for the second of five annual renewals as agreed to and specified in the bid contract EL008729 dated July 28, 2008.
2. To authorize and direct the Director of Recreation & Parks to transfer Southern Pines Park Parcel ID 010-080653 to Columbus Public Schools for re-development of the Cedar Wood Elementary School and greater serve the Southside Community. Columbus Public Schools wishes to transfer Beatrice School property, Parcel ID 010-105987, and the Sharon School site, Parcel ID 010-11066 to the City of Columbus for park space; and to declare an emergency.
3. To authorize the Director of Recreation and Parks to accept a grant from the Ohio Cultural Facilities Commission in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for historic and cultural improvements to Livingston Park; to authorize an appropriation of \$1,000,000.00 from the unappropriated balance of the Recreation and Parks Grant Fund to the Recreation and Parks Department; and to declare an emergency.
4. To authorize and direct the Director of Recreation and Parks to enter into contract with E.H. Herrick Engineering, Ltd. for professional services related to 2010 Inspection of Park owned bridges, to authorize the expenditure of \$20,940.00 from the Voted 1999/2004 Parks and Recreation Bond Fund.

5. To authorize and direct the Director of Recreation and Parks to accept a grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 from the Walmart Foundation received through the National Recreation and Parks Association to expand our summer food program; to appropriate these funds to the Recreation and Parks Private Grant Fund; and to declare an emergency
6. To authorize and direct the Director of Recreation and Parks to accept a grant in the amount of \$50,588.68 from and enter into agreement with the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services; to appropriate \$50,588.68 to the Recreation and Parks Grant Fund; and to declare an emergency.
