## ***Public Feedback***

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***1. What is the best way to enhance the North Market?***

- Begin revitalization of broader North Market Historic District
- Build an open plaza with underground parking
- Create 24/7 activity
- More special events
- More grocery options
- Allow for easier accessibility during special events and races
- More transit options
- Create bigger footprint
- Provide more child-centric events and entertainment
- Build a shared commercial kitchen/commissary

***2. How can this project best benefit the neighborhood?***

- Increase parking
- Preserve and enhance outdoor space
- Bigger farmers market
- Diversity and affordability from vendors
- Reroute races
- Space for more vendors
- Preserve the character of the area
- Feature archaeological aspects of the site
- Create an “all-day neighborhood”



- Build a cap to Goodale Parke with pedestrian connectors
- Create an open plaza around the market

### ***3. What would inspire you to visit the North Market more often?***

- Better traffic pattern for better pedestrian accessibility and safety
- More merchants
- Increased accessibility during races and special events
- Protecting fresh food merchants and expand the farmers market
- Sensitivity to small business owners from the North Market regarding hours
- Green space
- Accommodating parking during transition
- Space for other forms of transit: bike parking, scooters, etc.
- More diverse and innovative merchants
- Kitchen for catering and private classes
- Better pedestrian access
- Build an open plaza with underground parking
- Maintaining and enhancing the unique character of the district
