



My "aha" moment for this project came as I read an article in the Dispatch regarding a competition to design art/bike installations for city recreation centers. Knowing the need for and the acceptance of more public art, and needing more bike racks to make our Brewery more bike friendly, I came up with this art/bike rack idea which accomplishes both goals in one project.

This project has been reviewed by all the appropriate city departments, including the Public Right of Way staff, and the design and location have been approved.

This installation will be privately financed and privately maintained, and the Brewery will carry the necessary liability insurance. Please note the use of stainless steel which requires only minimal cleaning. We have contracted Heritage Equipment (a local company) to fabricate the structure. We hope to have it completed and installed in early spring.

The proposed location is in the public right of way directly in front of 171 N. 4th. St. The structure will be in a position perpendicular to the building so it can be viewed going north on N. 4th. St.
