The CAC granted Conceptual Approval at the 12-19-17 hearing Commissioners: Nance and Gray served on the Plan's Community Advisory Committee

The Columbus firm, Designing Local, has completed the Art on High Public Art Plan. Their team included former art administrator, artist and curator, Marc Pally, Landscape design and planning firm, MKSK Studios, and strategic visual communication and architectural graphic design firm, Kolar Design, Inc. Consultants completed the Art on High Strategic Public Art Master Plan document by the end of November, with two meetings held after the holidays: 1. An additional Advisory Committee Meeting in January and 2. A community open house to introduce the Plan.

Eight potential public art locations were identified within the planning area on High Street between Poplar Avenue and 8th Avenue. The locations are identified in the plan, which also contains a map of the Department of Public Service (DPS) Planning area. The Plan has two Apendixes, one containing the Artist Request for Qualifications and the other containing community input [results of community input surveys].

The project is on track for an Early April release of the Artist RFQ. The Department is looking into retaining Designing Local through the artist selection phase.
