SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2020 Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment

This letter is to acknowledge the City's request for a substantial amendment to the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan. The Columbus Field Office reviewed the proposed substantial amendment and accepts the following changes to the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan:

AP-35 Projects:

- 1. The budget of Project 28, CV-Public Restrooms, is increased by \$403,635. The amended budget for this project is \$1,278,635 (CDBG-CV funds).
- 2. The budget of Project 32, CV-Safe Recreation, is increased by \$530,000. The amended budget for this project is \$946,200 (CDBG-CV funds).
- 3. A new project, Project 35, CV- Renovations of Columbus Public Health Department Building, is added with a budget of \$1,797,205 (CDBG-CV funds).
- 4. A new project, Project 34, CV- Sanctuary Night Human Trafficking Prevention and Victim Support, is added with a budget of \$100,000 (CDBG-CV funds).
- 5. A new project, Project 37, CV-Broadband Access in Low- to Moderate-Income Neighborhoods, is added with a budget of \$250,000 (CDBG-CV funds).
- 6. A new project, Project 36, CV- Wheatland Farm Complex Market Building Construction, is added with a budget of \$1.500,000 (CDBG-CV funds).
- 7. The budget of Project 33, CV-HVAC Improvements, is decreased by \$4,580,840. The amended budget for this project is \$388,000 (CDBG-CV funds).

The City submitted documentation that demonstrates that it complied with the applicable Citizen Participation requirements at 24 CFR 91.505 and 24 CFR 91.105. In addition, our review confirmed that the City amended the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan in IDIS.
