


Important coverage information about the Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) Vaccine



The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) and local health departments have identified an outbreak of measles and mumps in Ohio.

Ohio residents are encouraged to get vaccinated with the Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR) vaccine. Officials say anyone who has not received any doses of MMR and those who have received only one dose of MMR should be vaccinated.

Additionally, people born before 1987 are likely to have received just one or no MMR doses and should also be vaccinated.
