## Become a League of American Bicyclists Certified Instructor!

The Mayor’s Office is sponsoring a cohort (6 employees) to become League of American Bicyclists Certified Instructors. Registration is available on a first-come/first-served basis for those who commit to the following requirements:

1. Complete and pass a short, **online assessment** prior to May 8, 2015.
2. Attend the **Traffic Skills 101\*** course on Friday, May 8<sup>th</sup> from 8:30am – 3:30pm **OR** have already taken this course.
3. Attend and pass the three-day **League of Certified Instructor (LCI) Course\*** on June 3 from 5pm-9pm, June 4 from 8am-9pm **AND** June 5 from 8am-3pm. *(A \$300 value!)*

*\*The Traffic Skills 101 and LCI courses involve on-road riding. BYOBike, helmet and water.*

*\*\*All classes will meet at Citywide Training & Development, Chester C. Christie Training Center, located at 1111 E. Broad Street, Suite LL01, Columbus, OH 43205.*

Once certified, you will be required to:

- ✓ Maintain League membership annually. *(The first year is free. A \$40 value!)*
- ✓ Complete 12 hours of continuing education each year. Fulfilled with national, state, local bike summits, safety routes to schools training, teaching a course for LCI, attending related webinars or assisting with a league certified instructor course. A reporting form will be included in your packet after you are certified.
- ✓ Submit an annual renewal fee of \$25 to keep your certification current.
