## HOT TOPIC: WHO DO YOU CALL WHEN YOU HAVE A CHEMICAL SPILL IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO?

### Who do you call?

Call the following agencies in this order. Give the "Who, What, Where and When" to the agency.

- 1. Fire:** 911
- 2. Ohio EPA's Spill Number:** 1-800-282-9378  
*If the 1-800 number does not work, call (614) 224-0946*
- 3. Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security:** 614-794-0213 (ask for Chris Williams)

### When do you call?

- When the chemical flows off your property or leaves your property through the air.
- When the chemical gets into storm drains.
- When the chemical flows into a ditch, which goes to a creek or a stream.

### Within 30 days, send the spill report to:
