## Ohio Department of Health BAC Datamaster & Intoxilyzer 5000 Re-Certification Testing

The Ohio Department of Health, Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Testing (BADT) requires certified breath instrument operators to re-certify on an annual basis.

If you your Operator/Senior Operator Permit is expired, or will expire within the next six months you may be eligible to attend a re-certification testing session.

If your permit is expired by more than two (2) years on the date of a re-certification testing session, you may no longer renew it; you must re-take the entire two-day, senior operator course.

If your permit is expired by less than two (2) years on the date of a re-certification testing session, you may attend the re-certification testing and could resume breath testing on your certified device once you receive your new permit.

If your permit is not yet expired, and you will be within six (6) months of your expiration on the date of a re-certification testing session, you may attend the re-certification testing and continue to run breath testing on your certified device until your expiration date on your permit.
