Lighting and electrical improvements and more coming to Lynn and Pearl streets!

Work will begin the week of February 29

Plans have been completed by the city of Columbus and the Downtown Special Improvements District for improving Lynn Street between High and Third streets plus Pearl Street between Broad and Gay streets; see attached map. The project will:

- Install new electrical circuits for street lights
- Mount 26 street-light poles
- Erect two historic, freestanding clocks at Lynn & High and Pearl & Gay
- Build aesthetic dumpster enclosures protected by steel bollards filled with and set in concrete; see attached drawing

In addition:

- Work will be done in daylight, Monday Friday.
- Some street closures will be necessary but done in small sections and short durations.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times
- Underground work will be completed by May 13, weather permitting

Construction is scheduled to begin February 29 and finish by June 30, 2016, weather permitting.
