Cultural Arts Center's "Converging Boundaries" Exhibit Opens

On Fri., Sept. 5, the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department's Cultural Arts Center (CAC), 139 W. Main St., will open Christine Guillot-Ryan's multi-media exhibit, "converging Boundaries" with an artist's reception from 5:30 – 8:30 pm.

"Christine's work draws her viewer into a self-made affecting realm," said Geoffrey Martin, Administrator of the Cultural Arts Center. "They are able to use the bits and pieces in the collages to understand their internal world."

The exhibition, for which Eric Rausch is the curator, will be on display through Oct. 4. Art Lovers can get a sneak peak during the Glass Axis Benefit on Thurs., Sept. 4, from 5:30 – 7 pm at CAC.

"I use mixed media to explore the subjective nature of perception, and express the tension between the material and the intangible," said Guillot-Ryan. "Taking fragments of the external world, I merge them with paint to capture visions of morphing inner realities."
