The city of Columbus has completed design work to improve **Parsons Avenue between Livingston Avenue and Hosack Street**. The planned improvements will reduce traffic congestion, improve safety and upgrade pedestrian and bicycle facilities.

The project is scheduled to begin construction in summer 2016, weather permitting, and include:

- Resurfacing Parsons Avenue between Livingston and Hosack
- Constructing *Americans with Disabilities Act*-compliant curb ramps and bumpouts
- Reconfiguring travel lanes and parking to remove restrictions and provide shared-lane markings for bicyclists
- Removing four traffic signals and replacing with Stop signs on cross streets; upgrading remaining signals to mast-arm style
- Adding pedestrian countdown timers and push-button signals at crosswalks
- New signage

Representatives from the city of Columbus and design consultant Parsons Brinckeroff will be on-hand **to answer questions in an open-house format; no formal presentation will be given**. Exhibits illustrating roadway features and property impacts will be on display.
