Winter Session practice's will be held on Tuesday's, Thursday's, Friday's for 9-11 and 12-13y boys from 5:00p-6:00p. 6-8y boys will practice on Thursday nights from 7:00-8:00p Our season officially starts during the Winter Session. Schedule are now being finalized for the upcoming season. Team fee's are \$5.00 per participant. **Our first practice will be on January 12th at 5:00p. More details will be available at that time**

The league fee will be \$10.00 per participant and will include a jersey and a hat. We encourage players to bring their own equipment; however, we will have plenty of extra gloves, cleats, bats, and baseballs if needed.

Milo Mustangs are offering a Introduction to Baseball class for the Winter Session to teach the fundamentals of the game . This class will lay the ground work for our new program. 
Everyone 6 and older MUST have a leisure card to participate and enter the facility. Cost is \$1.00
