Thompson Summer Activities and Special Events

In-person registration for these activities begins Monday, June 9th 9am

Climbing Wall - Tuesday, July 15 from 3:30pm – 5pm. Children ages 6 – 12 between 55 – 250 pounds are welcome. Must have tie shoes and female participants must have shorts on, no skirts. Permission slips signed by a parent are required. FREE

Zoo Trip – Thursday, June 26 Participants ages 6 – 12 years old will go by bus and provided lunch at the Columbus Zoo on Thursday, June 26 8:30am – 3:30 pm. Permission slips are required. FREE

Zoombizi Bay- Wednesday, July 23 participants 6 – 12 years old can go with Thompson for \$16 per person. The bus will leave around 9am and be back around 3:30pm. Participants must pay for their own food at the park. Tickets can be purchased for ALL family members and participants can provide their own transportation. 2 and under free. Participants **MUST pre-register by July 20.**

Ice Skating- Friday, June 15 participants' ages 8 – 14 will travel by bus to go ice skating. The bus will leave around 12pm and return 4pm. DRESS WARM the rink is 45 degrees!!! Please eat before coming or pack a lunch. FREE

Out Door Education- Tuesday, June 17th starting at 1pm they will to do a free program for participants ages 14 and under. Live animals will be part of the program. Pre-registration required.

Hersey Track Meet- Wednesday, June 18 10am at South HS. Participants age 9 – 14 can run in various track events. Pre-registration required if participants will be going with Thompson. FREE

Wild Waves- Friday, July 25 participants ages 6 - 16 will be taken by Van to the Tuttle swimming pool leaving around 10am and returning at around 2pm. Pack a lunch, towel, and bring lots of water. Participants must have a leisure card. FREE
