This year's Honored Artist, educator, Debbie Jackson, is a graduate of Miami University (Ohio), where she majored in Art, receiving a B.S. degree in Education. She is retired from the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department where she taught art classes for 30 years at the Columbus Cultural Arts Center, Community, and Senior Centers. Currently, she teaches a variety of polymer clay classes and workshops at conferences, for Guilds, and other art-related venues. She currently lives in Columbus, Ohio. While Debbie is multi-talented, her interests lie in creating polymer clay jewelry, dolls and home decor. Her work has appeared in numerous galleries and exhibitions. She is presently selling her jewelry at Studios on High, an artists' co-operative in the Short North gallery district in Columbus.

During art venues, she sells Stewart Gill metallic paints, tools, rubber stamps and other unique products for polymer clay. Debbie served as president of the Columbus Polymer Clay Guild for several years and maintains membership with her local and national guild. She is also a member of the Ohio Designer Craftsmen and participates in their annual Winterfair craft show. She served for several years on the advisory board for the Polymer CAFE' magazine.
