Alcohol Use

If a customer wishes to have alcohol served during their event, they must obtain an “Alcohol Service Agreement” from the Columbus Recreation and Parks Department Rental and Permits Section. In conjunction, there is a \$150 service fee for the privilege of having alcohol at our sites. This service fee is in addition to the regular rental rate for the facility. The permit holder must be a responsible adult, age 21 or older, with proof of identification. The permit holder must pay the service fee and sign the “Alcohol Service Agreement” in person in order to receive this privilege. There is a \$100 expediting fee for any Alcohol Service Agreement that is paid for and signed less than 15 days prior to the event. This expediting fee is in addition to the service fee and the regular rental rates for the facility. The alcohol Service Agreement must be paid for and signed at least 15 days in advance of the event in order to avoid paying the expediting fee.

Conditions for Alcohol Use

The customer must hire an “Approved Beverage Contractor” for the service of all alcohol at your event. The list of approved beverage contractors is maintained by the Columbus Recreation and Parks Rental and Permits Section. A copy of this list is available upon request. Tickets may not be sold for events providing alcohol. There can be no collecting of money or tickets in association with the rental of the North Bank Pavilion either.
