

Genoa Park 2

Start on Washington Blvd going north

Turn right (east) on Broad St

Turn left (north) on Marconi Blvd

Turn left (west) on Long St

Enter the bike path at North Bank Park and continue west

Exit the Bike path at Rickenbacker Dr and Souder Ave

Turn left (south) on Souder Ave and cross over the river

Reenter the bike path on left (east)

Follow the ramp up to Washington Blvd at Genoa Park

Continue north on Washington Blvd and return to start

Course Maximum Capacity

1,000 participants

Park Rental / Misc. Fees

Genoa Park: Half Day (up to 6 hours) - \$300 / Full Day (over 6 hours) - \$600

Street Closure: \$75 (Washington Blvd between Broad St and Town St) submission of the Block Party/Street Closure application required.

Parking Meters on Course

36	Total
11	West side of Marconi Blvd from Broad St to Long St
6	East side of Marconi Blvd from Broad St to Long St
19	South side of Long St from Hanover St to Neil Ave

Removal of parking meters from service is not required. However, meters in service will allow cars to be parked on the course, and their departure cannot be prevented during race. The above parking meters can be removed from service by submitting a Parking Meter Request form.

Notifications

Race organizer is required to distribute written notifications to all residents and businesses along the course at least 15 days prior to the race.

Race organizers are encouraged to place race in progress signs on the bike path to notify recreational trail users of your race.

Traffic Control Devices

Please refer to the attached traffic control device maps for the course. It's the responsibility of the race organizer to obtain and coordinate proper placement of all devices in accordance with the City of Columbus traffic safety standards.

Genoa Park 2-1

Devices:

- 3 10' Type III Barricades
- 3 'Road Closed' signs
- 1 'Do Not Enter' signs
- 1 Type I block Party Barricades
- 1 Flashing Arrow Panel
- ~ 30 Cones

Instructions:

Close the West bound curb lane of Broad St between High and Front - 30 cones




Genoa Park 2-2

Devices:

- 2 10' Type III Barricades
- 1 Flashing Arrow Panels
- 1 'Road Closed Ahead' sign
- 1 'Do Not Enter' sign
- ~ 15 28" Cones with reflectors

Instructions:

Close South bound curb lane of Marconi Ave from at Long St - 15 Cones




Genoa Park 2-3

Devices:

- 2 10' Type III Barricades
- 1 'Road Closed' signs
- 1 'Do Not Enter' signs
- ~ 50 28" Cones with reflectors

Instructions:

- Set cones on center double yellow line from park entrance to path - 30 Cones
- Close North bound Souder through lane @ McKinley - 10 Cones
- Close East bound McKinley Ave left turn lane @ Souder - 10 Cones



Genoa Park 2-4

Devices:

- 3 10' Type III Barricades
- 1 Type I Block Party barricades
- 3 'Road Closed' signs
- 1 'Do Not Enter' signs
- 1 'Left Lane Closed Ahead' sign
- 1 'Road Closed Ahead' sign
- 1 Flashing Arrow Panel
- ~ 50 Cones

Instructions:

- Close the East bound Left lane of Broad St between the railroad and Starling - 20 cones
- Close the North bound right turn lane of Starling at Broad St - 15 cones
- Close the North bound right turn lane of Belle at Broad St - 15 cones
