Road improvements will be made on:


12 th Avenue	Katahdin Alley	Petrel Alley

Construction will include:

- New roadways and alleys
- Sidewalks, curb ramps, gutters and curbs
- Storm drainage system and water lines
- Street lights and trees
- Innovative green features such as rain gardens and pervious concrete curbs

Representatives from the city of Columbus, design consultant EMH&T and road-construction contractor John Eramo & Sons will be on hand at the open house **to answer questions in an open-house format. No formal presentation will be given.** Exhibits illustrating construction plans will be on display.
